I am smiling because of the faces seen below who are the incredible team of women I get to work with who encourage, challenge, and inspire me to be the best leader I can be. I am smiling because 2021 has not exactly been the year I thought it would be, but in many ways, it has been better than I even expected. I am still smiling from the incredible Hike for Life that happened on September 25th. It truly was the BEST HIKE EVER! I am smiling because, at the hike, we got to honor and remember a woman who has made a tremendous impact on The PCC as well as our entire community. I smile because Lois Dixon had the hope of Jesus, a love for the unborn (which led her to help begin The PCC), a gentle leadership style, and a life that was well lived. I am smiling because our supporters raised over \$150,000! I am smiling because we had over 500 people attend and walk at the Hike for Life to support the unborn and state that every life matters, and life begins at conception. I am smiling because I received word that our Hike for Life event made a special impact on a passerby: A gentleman in his sixties was out for his typical Saturday morning bike ride; the Midway Village bike path is part of his routine.
