HOW YOU BLESSED OUR MINISTRY IN 2023

We are so blessed to be able to tell our clients that their appointments are completely free of charge thanks to the support from our generous donors. It is your gifts that keep our Center going! In 2023, The PCC was supported by **1,148 individuals**, **48 businesses**, and **47 churches**.

As we look at our 2023 numbers, 44% of our income came from individual donors, just like you! 39% came from events (Banquet, Hike for Life, Baby Bottle Boomerang, and other fundraisers), 9% from local churches, 3% from grants, and 5% from business/corporate donations.



We budgeted to bring in \$700,000 in 2023, but thanks to our community and the Lord's provision, we brought in **\$873,776.** We spent a total of **\$663,240**, which leaves us with a net income of **\$210,536.**

SUPPORTING OUR COMMUNITY IN 2023

DIAPER GIVEAWAYS

On June 20th and November 14th, The PCC partnered with City First Church and the Northern IL Food Bank as they did a drivethru food distribution for the community. We were able to give away diapers and wipes to over **475** families through those two events!



EMERGENCY PACKS

Every two months, anyone in the community can come to our center and receive diapers, wipes, clothing, formula and other needed baby items. In 2023, we gave out **876** emergency packs.



CHRISTMAS PROJECT

Our great room was overflowing with Christmas presents in December. Friends of The PCC helped sponsor **22** client families! We loved seeing the joy it brought our clients when they picked up their gifts and fixings for Christmas dinner.



HOW YOU HELPED US REACH HER IN 2023

Marketing brings more clients to The PCC. It allows us to reach her where she is at, to serve her and to save lives. We invest in a wide variety of marketing avenues to reach her (and men) in our community facing an unplanned pregnancy, and we are continually looking for new ways to reach her. In 2023, we had the opportunity to expand our reach even more!



In January of 2023 our billboard went up at the intersection of Alpine Road and Morsay Drive. Thanks to your generosity at the end of the year, we now have a second billboard up at the intersection of Kilburn Avenue and School Street. Both of these billboards point people to the help and hope awaiting them at The PCC.

Since our clients are living in a digital age, and things like the abortion-pill are readily available online, we must have a strong online presence so when she's looking for an abortion, she finds our Center and the support we can give her first. Thanks to you, we have been able to increase our online advertising. Along with our paid Google Ads, we also now have SEO (Search Engine Optimization) and Geofencing. Both of these tools help more women, and men, find our Center, a safe place for them to receive help and hope.










YOUR SUPPORT PROVIDES HELP, HOPE, AND HEALING



Numerous clients have walked through our doors since our last newsletter. Each person's story is unique, but one common denominator of our clients, other than being pregnant, is past and or present abuse of one form or another. This can be a factor in many of our young ladies' decision—making process when it comes to choosing life or death for their babies. Clients do not want their child to go through what they have endured, and thus feel as though they are being merciful to save this baby from their reality by considering abortion.

One of our clients came to us after just turning 18 and finding herself pregnant. She had cared for her mom, who was struggling with numerous physical and emotional issues, since she was 12. After her mom passed away when she was 16, she left home because she could no longer endure living with an abusive father. As her story unfolded, her Client Advocate learned she had also been abused in her church. All that she had been taught of Jesus seemed a fairytale to her. She has had numerous toxic relationships, and the last one got her pregnant. After sharing the news of her pregnancy with him, he rejected her and wanted nothing to do with this baby.

She came to The PCC for a pregnancy test and ultrasound. During her ultrasound, tears flowed as she saw this little person moving around in her belly. At that moment, she fell in love and there was no question– she was going to choose life for this baby. Since choosing life, this momma is actively participating in our Countdown to Parenthood program. Her Client Advocate has had opportunities to dig deeper into her past and to take her through a series called *Recognizing The Cycle of Abuse*. Her Advocate gave her references for counselors in our area to help her in the healing process, to remind her that humans are flawed, but Jesus is not, to not give up on Him because of the failure of people.

This client has driven farther than most to come to her appointments. She has been open and willing to learn how to not to pass down abuse or dysfunction to her soon-to-be born son. We are praying that Jesus would continue to reveal Himself to her and her son as their Good, Good Father.

HOW TO PRAY FOR THE PCC IN 2024



- Pray for our team of staff and volunteers to abide in Christ and bear much fruit; apart from Him, we can do nothing (John 15:5).
- Pray for women to find us first so they can learn that abortion is not their only option.
- Pray for more Abortion Pill Reversal clients.
- Pray for fathers to connect with our Fatherhood Program.
- Pray for entire families to receive the free gift of salvation and grow in a new relationship with Christ.
- Pray for more churches to host Embrace Grace groups (embracegrace.com).
- Pray as we navigate how best to utilize our Mobile Medical Unit (Stork Bus) and the services we provide in order to reach more abortion-minded women.
- Pray for our wisdom as the abortion facility plans to open around the corner from us- we
 want The PCC to be a woman's first choice (and her partner's) when they need a
 pregnancy test, ultrasound, or STI testing. We want everyone to receive care in a lifeaffirming environment.
- Pray for wisdom, direction, and provision as our nursing team investigates expanding our STI testing services.



This year, we are planning TWO events! You can choose to attend either our brunch or dinner program. More information and formal invitations to come soon!




Champions of HOPE
